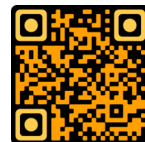

Rummage Sale

When Rev. April had people who helped with the United Women in Faith rummage sale stand up during worship the day after the sale ended, we could see how strongly our church community supported this annual fundraiser. Again this year, so many people, including many who aren't members of UWF, helped make the sale a big success.

Thank you all for your donations of items to sell, for providing snacks for the workers during rummage sale week, and for the help with setting up and putting away the tables in Miller Hall. Most of all, thanks to all the volunteers who were here for the six days when we were preparing for and then conducting the sale, which we see as an outreach to those in the community who depend on the ability to buy household items at a low cost.

When the sale was finished, we were able to provide donations to the Church of Christ clothing giveaway and the Midwest Mission Distribution Center, as well as Goodwill. After expenses, we have collected close to \$4,000 to support our missions, which include the Trinity Children and Youth, Neighbors in Need, the Salvation Army food pantry, Hope Harbor, First Light Child Advocacy Center, UMCOR, Epworth Village in York, the Big Garden in Omaha, Red Bird Mission in Kentucky and McCurdy School in New Mexico.
